Additional Schedule Information	LINUS is an application that records and tracks user fees for employee plans and exempt organizations. User fees are submitted when applying for approval of an employee pension plan or determination of tax exempt status. Data is entered into LINUS either as a manual transcription from a paper application, or via upload of a file created by manual download from the Pay.gov System. Pay.gov is a secure government-wide collection portal

administered by the Financial Management Service (FMS).

- The User Fee data is captured in LINUS and deposited daily. The data that is captured in LINUS can generate an acknowledgement notice to the filer and the POA representative. The acknowledgement notice language and format are generated per the application submitted. LINUS normally sends the data to Modified Employee Plans/Exempt Organizations Determination System (MEDS) and MEDS generates the acknowledgment notices. However, LINUS will generate the notices in the event that MEDS cannot. MEDS sends the data to Employee Plans-Exempt Organizations Determination System (EDS) under normal circumstances.
- If data cannot be sent to EDS via MEDS, then the data goes directly from LINUS to EDS.

The LINUS application has six modules that comprise application functionality. All six modules, with the exception of the database module, are client-side MS Access programs used to serve as the front-end for the LINUS application and are installed on the user's workstation.

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Data is stored in SQL Server Database. LINUS moves the EP and EO data every ten years to a storage server so DLNs may be reused.

EO information made publicly available under Section 6104 is considered to be a "matter of public record" [Treasury Reg. § 1. 6104(b)-1(a)]. Although the code and regulations are silent on the time-period for inspection, they could be interpreted (as IRS does) as requiring ongoing and continuous inspection (and supports "indefinite retentions" in this Schedule). In addition to these materials being a "matter of public record," the regulations also make clear that the availability for inspection prior to 1970 shall be pursuant to the provisions in effect at that time. See Treasury Reg. § 1.6104(b)-1(d) (3) ("returns filed before January 1, 1970, shall be available for public inspection only pursuant to the provisions of section 6104 in effect for such years. The information furnished on all returns filed after December 31, 1969, pursuant to the requirements of section 6033, 6034, or 6058, shall be available for public inspection in accordance with the provisions of section 6104. "). Thus, IRS/NARA stakeholders (including Counsel, during a call on June 7, 2022) have agreed to a long term 200-year retention.
