These PST files include both permanent Capstone and temporary non-Capstone email/data accounts that cannot be distinguished and separated and can no longer be restored. This obsolete software is no longer trustworthy or accessible. There is no capability to restore data to current email systems or network file systems. For these reasons IRS is asking to destroy these damaged/unreadable PST files.</li> <li>On September 30th, 2017, IRS successfully completed import of all</li> </ul>	
	discovered, healthy, and accessible PST files for IRS Main and Criminal Investigation (CI), as part of efforts to comply with NARA/OMB M-12-18 requirements for the management and retention of email records. IRS also executed two efforts to resolve damaged/unreadable PST files, beginning with a self-service effort in late 2017. This effort involved affected staff attempting self-repair and import of their PST files. This effort was followed by an enterprise-wide initiative to repair remaining unreadable Capstone Officials' PSTs in June 2018, and all non-Capstone users in April 2019, using a dedicated third-party technical support software ("Barracuda Software" - decommissioned). The PST files requiring destruction per approval of this request, are those that were not repaired as part of the above initiatives.
