IMS consists of two components, a laptop application and a centralized data repository. The IMS application provides the tools to support examination planning, examination selections, and the examinations themselves. IMS is used by revenue agents and specialists to set up the examination, request information from the taxpayers to work issues, propose adjustments, record hours applied to issues, and track elapsed time between activities.
