Following assignment of the sales to bond owner accounts the original stubs were retained for use as a means of post-auditing interest payments. Retention of these records was approved under Item 19-c of Comprehensive Records Schedule No. 1 dated July 29, 1955. However, as a result of conversion to Electronic Data Processing, these records have no further reference value. The bond and owner identification data reflected in these records is also contained in a file of duplicate stubs which is scheduled for permanent retention. Microfilm records are also available.</p> <p>Authority is requested to dispose of Series H and K original bond registration stubs with issue dates from May 1952 through December 1967.</p>
