The FAA Hotline is used by representatives of the aviation industry, the general public, and FAA employees to report and document issues involving aviation safety, violations of FAA regulations or policy, concerns involving FAA employees or facilities, maintenance issues, aircraft incidents, and/or aircraft accidents. The complaint should include: a detailed description of what is being reported, the names of individuals or organizations being reported, date and time when the event occurred, the specific area of concern, as well as any and all supplemental material provided by the reporting individual. Reports include inequities or operational safety concerns that are not being addressed through other agency processes. Reports are not intended to be used when other channels for dealing with problems and solutions such as agency grievance procedures, discrimination complaints or other formal appeal processes exists. The reports are also not be used to bypass the exclusive representation provided by bargaining units recognized by the FAA.

The AIR21 Whistleblower Protection Program (WBPP) provides protection to employees of air carriers, as well as their contractors and subcontractors, from discrimination, discharge, or retaliation due to providing information relating to any violation of any order, regulation, or standard of the FAA or other Federal law relating to air carrier safety. The complaint should include: name, address, and telephone number, the individual's understanding of the specific order, regulation, or standard of FAA, that they believe has been violated, the name and location of the company which discharged or otherwise discriminated against the individual; their status as an air carrier, air carrier contractor or subcontractor the date individual became aware of the discrimination, the specific issue reported to the company or to the FAA, specific details relating to the safety issue such as people involved, aircraft tail numbers, date and times of the event(s), witness list, and sufficient details to allow the FAA inspectors to prove a violation of a regulation, order, or standard.

The FAA has a direct line of communication with the public by responding to their noise complaints and inquiries. (Pursuant to Public Law 104-264, Section 1210

Federal Aviation Reauthorization Act of 1996; 49 U.S.C. § 40101 Public Law 112-95, Section 510; and Public Law 115-254 Section 180 FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018 regarding aircraft noise.) After review and research, the FAA develops a response to the complainant. That response either explains the situation or provides the complainant with additional resources or other points of contact to assist them better. Statistical data and related reports primarily collected from noise complaints associated with a specific geographic location are developed/tracked to determine if additional resources are required. Aspects of this data include: air traffic procedure use, aviation safety, operational concerns, the average response times for complaints, the number of responses due within a specified window of time, overdue complaints, and airports with a high level of complaints or inquiries.
