


They are statements submitted by shipbuilders and ship operators who hold or apply for a contract under the Act, as well as persons employed or retained by them, in compliance with Section 807 of the Merchant Marine Act, 1936, as amended (46 App. USC 1225). The statement identifies the matters addressed under the shipping acts before the Congress or a committee thereof or the "Commission", the nature of the employment or retainer, and the compensation received and expenses incurred.</p> <p>(Section 807 was repealed by PL 101-224 on 12/12/89.
