10. ACTION TAKEN

In May 1977 the Maritime Administration (MarAd) undertook a program, in the Office of Maritime Manpower, of reviewing accession 357-65A-282 which consisted of original applications for decorations and letters (awards), medical records including sign on examinations, outpatient treatment cards, and full case histories of merchant seamen by individual name. These records date from 1940 to the pre-This accession contained 1544 cubic feet of records. The review plan called for a thorough review of each individual seamen's file with the idea of removing any information which MarAd had no use nor authority for maintaining. Secondly, it was felt that this weeding-out process would bring MarAd closer to full compliance with the Privacy Act of 1974. The informative material remaining on the merchant seaman was then coded onto a newly prescribed compact form, and as a result the accession was reduced to 46 cubic feet.

Next, effort was made to return the 46 cubic feet to the Suitland, Maryland Federal Records Center for continued storage, and herein lies the problem.

The previous accession 65A-282 was scheduled as Clinical Records with disposal authorization II-NNA-1918 and a retention period of 75 years after the date of birth of each individual seaman. Because all clinical or medical
