Additional Schedule Information

The Close Call Data System (CCDS) is a suite of application software that facilitates the full cycle of the close call reporting for a variety of customers. Its primary function is to support safety related incident and failure reporting, conduct employee interviews, provide statistical analysis and corrective actions (if appropriate) to the customer, participants, or industry stakeholders, and protect the confidentiality of these data through the Bureau of Transportation Statistics (BTS) statute (49 U.S.C. 6302) and Confidential Information Protection and Statistical Efficiency Act (CIPSEA). BTS is sponsoring the Close Call Data System (CCDS) to demonstrate the effectiveness of reporting of close calls or near misses in improving safety. The Close Call information is used to identify root causes and corrective actions as well as industry-wide patterns which improve environmental and transportation safety. CCDS' secondary function is to support the collection and analysis of operational data of companies in the logistics industry. The operation data is used to develop measures of U.S. freight and shipping network capacity and statistical indicators of goods moving throughout the supply chain.

The purpose of CCDS is to help the Bureau of Transportation Statistics (BTS) fulfill its primary function to compile and analyze relevant and accurate data and disseminate information for statistical purposes, thereby allowing the users to make informed decisions. The Close Call Data System has four different types of modules that can be used to support each client. Each client has one or more of the modules described below which are then tailored to their specific business requirements.

• Web Portal Module: Allows registered users to upload data. May provide read-only access to previously submitted information and a dashboard with trend data.

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	 Close Call Process Manager (CCPM) Module: Close Call Program/BTS staff facing function module of CCDS to support internal processing procedures working on submitted data. The Subject Matter Expert (SME) and analysts use the module to review submitted data and additional information about the reported data. For some clients, the SMEs compile information about the close-call incident, perform guided, systematic root cause analysis of the close-call incident, and develop a list of corrective action recommendations. Also known as the Multiple Cause Incident Analysis (MCIA) tool. Preventative Safety Action (PrSA) Module: a workflow engine designed to manage the corrective actions throughout their lifecycle. When a corrective action is drafted during the MCIA process, it will go through a PrSA process that tracks the corrective action through its lifecycle from the recommendation of the corrective action to the completion of the implementation of the corrective action. Company Name Tool Module: helps Close Call staff manage name and ownership changes of companies reporting data. This schedule also covers records created by the Peer Review Team that aren't captured in the Preventative Safety Action (PrSA) Module.
