The Bureau of the Census conducted the 1969, 1977, 1983 and 1990 Nationwide Personal Transportation Surveys for the Department of Transportation. The Research Triangle Institute conducted the 1995 NPTS data collection effort for the Federal Highway Administration. Starting in 2001, the NPTS was subsumed by the National Household Travel Survey of the Bureau of Transportation Statistics.
