1	Motor Vehicle Occupant Safety Survey (MVOSS) Cognitive Testing.  As part of the preparation for the Motor Vehicle Occupant Safety Survey (MVOSS), a cognitive testing protocol is implemented. Nine adults are administered selected questions from the MVOSS and then interrogated about their thoughts concerning the questions. This process is known as cognitive testing. The records compiled during the cognitive tests are handwritten notes and audiotapes. These notes contain only first names of the individuals tested. As part of the cognitive testing, individuals sign consent forms and forms acknowledging receipt of payment. The record information collected during the cognitive tests consist of paper and audiotape formats. The subjects are recruited using a pre-existing database owned by the facility retained to provide the logistical resources for the cognitive tests. This system is external to the NHTSA and MVOSS project.
