Deactivation is a permanent solution, the airbag will always be inoperable. Only authorized dealers and repair shops can perform the required modifications. Highway Traffic Salety Administration (NHTSA) via a form from the website which must be printed out and submitted, or from a letter along with supporting documentation, such as a physician's statement Approval is granted by a letter from the NHTSA Chief Counsel's office, which the requestor then brings to an authorized auto shop or dealer If permission is granted for permanent disconnection, a sticker is placed on the vehicle.
