Background Information      The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) VHA requires each VA Medical Center (VAMC) to conduct EOC Rounds at each VAMC health care facility, to include Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC). These EOC rounds are performed at a minimum of twice per fiscal year (FY) to meet The Joint Commission (TJC) Elements of Performance for Environment of Care EC.04.01.01 - Organizational Monitoring.

Designated VHA employees manage EOC compliance as it relates to patient care activities, capturing deficiency data in real-time to identify potential patient safety risks or other EOC issues and generating time-sensitive corrective actions. Currently EOC records are created and maintained by service lines/program offices at the VA medical facilities in both paper and electronic form. EPS is phasing in a new automated system to capture all facility EOC records in a standard electronic format and to store all records in a central location at the AITC by June 2014. As the facility EOC records are input to the Master File/Database, the dispositions below will be applied.
