1.	<p>Public Law No. 97-377 (Quayle Amendment) replaced, for certain survivors of veterans, payments which were previously reduced or terminated by the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981. This benefit is payable to certain surviving spouses and school children who are survivors of a member or former member of the Armed Forces who died while on active duty before August 13, 1981. Reinstated Entitlement Program for Survivors (REPS) lightweight claims folders are created for eligible claimants and all are maintained at the St. Louis Regional Office. The folder and contents have served their usefulness once all potential claimants' periods of eligibility have expired or the cases are closed otherwise.
