	The Office of the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) is responsible for the development and coordination of U.S. international trade, commodity, and direct investment policy, and overseeing negotiations with other countries. The Office is headed by the U.S. Trade Representative, a Cabinet-level official with the rank of Ambassador, who reports directly to the President of the United States. The U.S. Trade Representative serves as the President's principal trade advisor, negotiator, and spokesperson on trade issues. The Office also consists of three Deputy U.S. Trade Representatives and a Chief Agricultural Negotiator each holding the rank of Ambassador, and professional staff.
	Through consultation with the interagency trade policy organization, USTR has primary responsibility for U.S. international trade policy. USTR executes its institutional interagency role by chairing two processes, the Trade Policy Review Group (TPRG) and the Trade Policy Staff Committee (TPSC) comprised of 19 Federal agencies to review trade policy matters.
