Approximately 32,000 petitions (6 cu. ft), sent by members of Judicial Watch, urging the Archivist of the United States to expedite the release of Hilary Clinton White House documents that are subject to a Judicial Watch FOIA request and lawsuit. All forms are identical except for the signature and date.
