(With Inclusive Dates or Retention Periods) The Interstate Commerce Commission was established in 1887 as an independent agency responsible for the regulation of all surface transportation within the United States. The goal of the Commission is to assure an adequate and efficient transportation system for the American public. The ICC has regulatory authority over approximately 18,000 surface transportation companies in the United States including railroads, trucking companies, bus lines, water carriers, freight forwarders and transportation brokers. The ICC is directed by 11 Commissioners, appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate for a seven year term. Commissioners supervise all activities of the agency with specific responsibilities delegated to 10 bureaus and offices. The Chairman is the executive head of the Commission.
