MEDIA RELEASE FILMS AND VIDEOTAPES

This series contains 16mm films and/or 3/4-inch umatic videotapes released to the media regarding various TVA programs. Some of the categories of subjects covered in these media releases are TVA projects, significant events in TVA's history, and information about TVA programs offered to the public. The inclusive dates are the mid-1950's and continuing. The media releases for the mid-1950's to 1980 were on 16mm film, and beginning in 1980 they are on videotape. There are approximately 30 cubic feet of original 16mm films and very few duplicates. There are approximately 25 cubic feet of original videotapes and 50 cubic feet of duplicate tapes. There is more than one duplicate of most of the videotapes.
