AREA DISPATCH AND CONTROL CENTER (ADCC) SYSTEM ALARM SUMMARY

A computer printout is prepared automatically and continuously at substations by instruments installed at various points on substation transmission equipment and related auxiliary equipment. The purpose of the system is to track transmission equipment activity. This summary records precise time each piece of transmission equipment opens and closes and when equipment is in or out of operational limits as well as when equipment returns to a normal operational mode. Essential data from this summary is transferred to the Dispatchers Daily Log (NN-165-127). The data used for backup are filed with the appropriate Dispatcher Daily log. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission requires that generation and output logs with supporting data be maintained for 6 years. Because the charts are important in connection with legal problems relating to power system troubles affecting municipalities, industrial customers, or the public in general, it is recommended that the charts and supporting documentation be maintained for 7 years to meet requirements of the statutes of limitations for civil actions arising from contractual arrangements.

DISPOSITION

- A. Printout used for supporting data:
 - Destroy with corresponding Daily Dispatchers Log when 7 years old.

B. Printout not used for supporting data:

Destroy when no longer needed not to exceed 2 years.
