1 Hartsville Nuclear Plant Access Railroad Study

These records consist of the studies and design work done by the architect-engineering firm of Harland Bartholomew and Associates on the Hartsville Nuclear Plant access railroad. This series also includes reproducible drawings, computations, and survey notes.

Since the construction of a rail barge facility will be made in lieu of the access railroad, the records are of value to TVA only if management reactivates the plans for the railroad.

A 5-calendar year retention period for these records would allow ample time for the construction of the rail barge facility and/or for management to approve or permit the access road to be built.
