## Program Features

o Energy Surveys and Recommendations

Regardless of the type of fuel used in heating or cooling a home, all residential consumers are eligible for the free home energy survey upon request. onsite inspection is conducted by TVA-trained energy advisors to determine the insulation or weatherization levels of the attic, floor, ductwork, water heater, windows, doors, and other areas of the home. the inspection is completed, the energy advisor recommends improvements where needed, their potential savings, and the estimated cost of these improvements.
