June 30, 2020, the Commission's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau designated Huawei Technologies Company and ZTE Corporation, and their parents, affiliates, and subsidiaries, as companies that pose such threats, and thus the prohibition against the use of USF support applies to them.

December 11, 2020, the Commission implemented the Secure and Trusted Communications Networks Act of 2019, which created the Secure and Trusted Communications Networks Reimbursement Program (Reimbursement Program) and prohibited prospective use of certain federal subsidies, including USF funds or funding appropriated to the COVID-19 Programs, to purchase, rent, lease, or otherwise obtain any covered communications equipment or service, or maintain any covered communications equipment or service previously purchased, rented, leased, or otherwise obtained.
