Local Telephone Competition and Broadband Reporting (FCC Form 477) is a series of information collections. The collections provide standardized information to support the FCC's statutory responsibilities to evaluate and encourage deployment of advanced telecommunications capability to all Americans, to take appropriate actions to open all telecommunications markets to competition, and to encourage innovation and investment.

A. Data Inputs/Source Records:

A.1. December 31, 1997 – June 30, 1999. A limited number of respondents submitted specified information on a voluntary basis on five (5) occasions to assist the Commission to develop a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to pursue broader issues regarding competition in local clecommunications services The information was submitted in Microsoft Excel ("Excel") worksheets on diskettes, and a duplicate paper copy of the worksheet was provided

Disposition: Destroy source records five (5) years after submission

A.2. <u>December 31, 1999 – December 31, 2004</u>. Required information was reported in Excel worksheets via small or on diskettes. The information was read into a Microsoft Access ("Access") database. Required certification statements were delivered via email or postal mail and were filed as paper sopies

Disposition: Destroy/delete source records and destroy certification statements five (5) years after data are entered into the system (Access database)

A.3. <u>June 30, 2005 – June 30, 2008</u>. Required information was reported in Excel worksheets delivered via email and was read into a SAS dataset. Required certification statements were delivered via email or as paper copies and were filed as paper copies.

Disposition Destroy/delete source records and destroy certification statements five (5) years after data are entered into the system (SAS dataset).

A.4. <u>December 31, 2008 – present</u>. Respondents use a secure web interface to onter specified information into a Sybase relational database. The required certification is incorporated in the web interface Respondents are authenticated using FCC Registration Number (FRN) through the Commission Registration System (CORES).

Disposition Destroy/delete information in the Sybase relational database five (5) years after the due date of the data collection.
