## Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) Public Affairs

## **Background**

Public Affairs (PA) mission has remained largely unchanged over the last 20 years. It functions as the agency's primary contact with the news media, and is responsible for preparing and distributing press releases and a variety of publications that provide information on the agency's benefit programs. The Congressional Inquiry section is responsible for responding to all inquiries from congressional offices concerning constituents, benefit claims or applications filed with the agency.

## Justification of Proposed Retention(s)

<u>Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) Records</u> - This is a new series that consists of records associated with the management of the RRB's annual CFC initiative. Split into two sub-items, the proposed retention(s) for sub-item (a) and sub-item (b) which is a PC-spreadsheet file used to track CFC donors and contribution amounts, satisfy all RRB legal, fiscal and administrative needs.
