The Commission was composed of twelve citizens, four each appointed by the President, Speaker of the House, and President pro tempore of the Senate. It held six days of public hearings in June, July and August 1990 and invited testimony — both oral and written — from distinquished individuals and organization representatives. The Commission submitted its final report on September 11, 1990. Briefing Books These books were compiled by Commission staff and distributed to Commissioners prior to public hearings in June, July and August 1990.
