The Commission was required to report to Congress by December 31, 1993. However, in 1993, Congress extended the due date for the final report until December 31, 1994, as part of the Treasury Department appropriations legislation (P.L. 103-123). The Commission released the report on December 29, 1994. The Commission terminated January 31, 1995.


