

FEDERAL ENTITY CEASED OPERATIONS

Schedule Number: NC1-220-77-02

Federal entities may cease operations when they are established as a temporary entity, are abolished, or functions are transferred to state or local government or private control.

Description:

The National Commission for the Review of Federal and State Laws Relating to Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance was established by section 804, Title III of P.L. 90-351, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, dated June 19, 1968. The Act provided that section 804 would go into effect five years after enactment of the bill, that is, June 1973.

Section 804 of the Act was repealed in 1970 by Publ. L. 91-452, thereby abolishing the Commission and establishing the National Commission on Individual Rights but it was restored in 1971 by Publ.L. 91-644, which repealed the 1970 law.

The Commission terminated on June 30, 1976.

The Wiretap Commission File was used by the National Commission for the Review of Federal and State Laws Relating to Wiretapping and Electronic Surveillance to assist in the study and evaluation of the effectiveness of Title III of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968. This section governs the use of electronic surveillance in the United States except in cases of national security. The file contains data collected by the Commission in a survey of prosecuting attorneys on the results of wiretaps during the years 1968-1973. Data elements include; agency involved; crimes listed in the application for wiretap; number of persons arrested, indicted, convicted, acquitted, and dismissed by offense or why none; sentences imposed; indictments pending; and other resulting wiretaps.

Disposition: Destroy files upon termination of the Commission.
