Damaged NASA Headquarters Still Photograph Collection

A water damaged subset of the NASA Headquarters photo reference collection comprised of derivative images submitted by the NASA Centers to HQ to comprise a centralized source for image copies of interest to the public and press. Each file contained captions and some multi-media combination of transparencies, negatives, hardcopy prints, and/or slides. The full headquarters collection is scheduled as Permanent under NASA Records Retention 5/23B1(b).

The photo materials in this collection subset were destroyed by water damage incidents in both 2001 and 2002, and represents 28 percent of the full Headquarters collection. This subset consists of 9,680 (4,395 black and white; 5,285 color) files of unrecoverable captions, outer envelopes, prints, negatives and/or transparencies.
