It is used to create requests for acquisition, assistance and interagency agreement awards and modifications, generate various documents required during the procurement process. The New Management System (NMS) records awards, receipts, and acceptance of deliverables. Data is input by NMS users to support Acquisition and Assistance requirements. NMS is interfaced with agency Financial Management System - Phoenix.
