This request is for the continued retention of 1461 cubic feet of records accumulated during the period 1948-1961 by U.S. Overseas Missions located in Austria, Belgium, Bolivia, Brazil, Burma, Cambodia, Ceylon, Chile, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Denmark, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, El Salvador, Ethiopia, France, Germany, Greece, Haiti, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Italy, Japan, Jordan, Korea, Laos, Liberia, Libya, Mexico, Netherlands, Norway, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Portugal, Saudi Arabia, Switzerland, Thailand, Turkey, United Kingdom, Uruguay, Venezuela, Vietnam, and Yugoslavia.

These missions provided economic aid assistance to the host countries as part of the U.S. foreign aid programs administered by predecessor agencies (1948-1961) of the Agency for International Development: Economic Cooperation Administration (ECA), 04/03/48 - 10/31/51; Mutual Security Agency (MSA), 11/01/51 - 07-31/53; Technical Cooperation Administration (TCA), 06/01/50 - 07/31/55; Foreign Operations Administration (FOA), 08/01/53 - 06/30/55; and International Cooperation Administration (ICA), 07/01/55 - 11/03/61.

The subject files that are recommended for retention (Item 1) are both mission Centralized Subject Files, and Decentralized Subject Files for those missions that did not have centralized files. Most of the decentralized files for those missions that have central subject files have been recommended for disposal on a separate SF 115 since their informational content is largely duplicated in the Central Subject Files. It should also be noted that much of the Mission's activities is documented in the files of the Wsahington offices of the predecessor agencies. Most of those offices' files have been recommended for retention on a separate SF 115.

All of the missions' accumulated subject files are identified as a single series, which is followed by a listing of the applicable missions and WNRC accession and box numbers. The remainder of the records are grouped together first by country and then by the individual records series.
