Harry C. Kelly Subject File. Office file of Kelly, who served as NSF Assistant Director for Scientific Personnel and Education (1951-59) and Associate Director, Educational and International Activities (1959-62). The major part of the file consists of Kelly's correspondence with many Japanese scientists, engineers, and business leaders. Also included are "diary notes" of telephone calls and meetings, annotated budget documents, and statements and background material for congressional hearings. Total volume: 2 cubic feet.
