Surveys consist of multiple questionnaires sent to a sample populations of waste generators and treatment, storage, disposal and recycling facilities. Information was used to generate a final report and two data bases. Records consist of questionnaires, drawings, facility maps, and supporting materials returned by respondents.

SERIES TITLE: Hazardous Waste Generators Survey Data Base

DESCRIPTION:

This data base contains information on hazardous waste generators and is used for regulatory development. The information is from a sample of approximately 10,000 generators and includes the following types of data: types and volumes of hazardous waste generated, accumulation of hazardous waste, testing procedures, existing tanks used for treatment, and waste minimization activities. Information is from a one-time survey conducted in 1986-87 and is based on a sample of waste generators. Records are in flat file format.

IDENTIFYING INFORMATION:

SERIES TITLE: Hazardous Waste TSDR Facilities Survey

DESCRIPTION:

This data base contains information on a sample of approximately 3,000 hazardous waste treatment, storage, disposal and recycling facilities. The information is collected from 1 general information questionnaire and 14 specialized questionnaires. The general facility questionnaire solicited information on: volumes, capacity, waste characterization, pricing, and pollution control. The specialized questionnaires obtained detailed information on the various management methods listed below: incineration, refuse as fuel, fuel blending, solidification / stabilization, solvent and liquid recovery for reuse, metals recovery for reuse, wastewater treatment, waste piles, surface impoundments, landfills, land treatment, underground injection wells, and tank systems. Information is from a one-time survey conducted in 1986-87 and is based on a sample of facilities. Records are in flat file format with minimal documentation.
