The survey collected data on the demographic and freshwater recreation characteristics of 5,724 randomly selected households in four northeastern states: Maine, New Hampshire, New York, and Vermont. Separate panels were administered to fishermen, boaters, and swimmers. The questionnaires collected data on individual characteristics on each site that was visited and each trip taken. The variables included information on household characteristics, trip expenditures, on-site expenditures, visited site characteristics, travel distances and times, and catch information for the fishing panel. Questionnaires were administered in July and October 1989 (Waves 1 and 2).
