

(10) Case files for the United States Court of Federal Claims (formerly known as the United States Claims Court and its predecessor, the Court of Claims).

The Court of Federal Claims was established by Congress in 1982, with nationwide jurisdiction over various money claims against the United States, in excess of \$10,000 (28 U.S.C. § 1346 and § 1491). The court hears suits involving government contracts, constitutional claims, tax refunds, Indian claims, civilian and military pay claims, patents and copyright matters, and vaccine injury claims. The court is also authorized to review agency decisions under various federal compensation programs.

For purposes of this schedule, "close of case" occurs on the date of entry of final judgment that is not appealable. See 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d)(2)(G) ["final judgment . . . means a judgment that is final and not appealable, and includes an order of settlement"].
